A fund for women parishioners living in hardship.

Times of difficulty can happen to us all. If you are in a situation where you are struggling to pay for personal or household items, this fund may be able to help you.

The Deakin and Withers Fund was set up many years ago to support single, women over the age of 40, living in hardship or facing financial difficulty. Administered by South Yorkshire's Community Foundation, the fund is currently open to applications.

To apply you must be:

- Applicants must be active members of a church
- A women who is single, divorced or widowed
- Over the age of 40

The funding can support a range of different needs, such as:

- A range of essential household items
- Utility and energy bills

Each grant application is assessed on its own merit and help is offered dependent on individual circumstances. Most of our awards are for around £500. If you are successful the award is made within six weeks of receiving your application.
